The proposal is to host a reciprocal annual competition in Australia, open to all classes permissible in NSW. Trophies, Prizes and Medallions will be presented in all classes as well as a grand aggregate medallion by the NSWMLA.

All match conditions and rules are conducted within the published rules and matches of the LERAA CSR Handbook.

- Match 1 - Friday 17th April – The Dorset Dabble (40 ROUNDS)
- Match 2 – Saturday 18th April – The Colonial Rifle Match (60 ROUNDS)
- Match 3 – Sunday 19th April – The Anzac Trophy (60 ROUNDS)

CLASSES (for details please see the LERAA CSR Handbook)

- a. Historic Enfield – SMLE, No4 or No5 303 in as issued configuration
- b. Any Iron – all bolt action military rifles up to 8mm in original configuration
- c. Service Optic - Calibre is restricted to 7.62x51 mm, 5.56x45 mm or .303 British.
- d. Practical Optic – up to 8mm

All firearms used must comply with NSW firearms legislation. All rifles and ammunition will be subject to scrutiny prior to the competition.

- Match 1 – Medallions in each class with entries over 6 participants for 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
- Match 2 – Winner in Historic Enfield the Colonial Rifle Match Trophy
Cash prizes for SMLE and No4 rifle with entries over 6 participants.
Gold Medallion in each class.
- Match 3- Winner in SMLE the LERAA Anzac Trophy
Medallions in each class with entries over 6 participants for 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
