Hosted by Sporting Shooters Association of Australia (NSW), Mudgee and District Branch Inc (N18). Windamere Regional Shooting Complex, Castlereagh Highway, 36Km South of Mudgee.

The National Event for Combined Services enthusiasts, keen competitors and those who appreciate both historic and contemporary service firearms. Come along and enjoy the company of like-minded people over 3 days of friendly competition.

The programme will be conducted in accordance with the SSAA Combined Services Official National Rulebook No.5, 2022.

Please note: Scheduling of events may be altered pending final competitor numbers in each event.

Thursday 18th September - Practice: Ranges 2 and 3, 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

Friday 19th September, Pistol Events, Range 3:

Pistol Scrutineering 7:00 am. Briefing at 8:10 am. Competition begins 8:30 am.

Class 1, 2 & 3 pistols. Class 1 to be shot first. Competitors may only shoot two classes.

Event 2: Match 2	25Mtr Three Position Deliberate.	Open & Junior.
Event 3: Match 1	3P Core Event (shot 25m, 15m, 7m)	Graded & Junior.

Event 5: Match 6	Standing Rapid Fire 15m.	Open & Junior.

Please Note: Pistols not on the Class 1 or 2 Approved Lists will not be eligible unless pre-approved

Class 3 Pistols are a Modified Class 1 or 2 as per Rule 6.2.1

Medals awarded for all pistol events, Teams event, Top gun and Top gun Junior. Top gun and Teams event based on combined scores Class 1 pistol events 1, 3, 5.

Friday, 19th September, Rifle Events, Range 2:

Rifle Scrutineering from 1:00 pm. Briefing at 1:40 pm. Competition begins 2:00 pm.

Class A Rifles (Carbines) Only.

Event 1: Match 5 Rapid Fire C (100m) Open grade. Event 2: Match 13 Action M (100m) Open grade. **Combined Services Sub-committee AGM** as soon as possible after Friday matches conclude.

Saturday, 20th September, Rifle Events, Range 2: Rifle Scrutineering 8:00 am. Briefing at 8:30 am. Competition begins 8:45 am.

Standard Rifle to be shot first. Competitors may compete in two classes only.

Event 3: Match 4 Rapid Fire B (100m)

Standard (Open & Junior), Accurised (Open), and International Optic Class (Open).

Event 4: Match 10 Deliberate 300M

Standard (Graded & Junior), Accurised (Open), and International Optic Class (Open).

Event 5: Match 1 3P Core Event (Shot 300m, 200m, 100m)

Standard (Graded & Junior) Accurised (Open) and International Optic Class (Open).

Saturday, 20th September, Rifle Events, Range 3:

Events will be conducted concurrently on Range 3 as Competitors become available after completing their chosen matches on Range 2.

Event 6: Match 20: 3P Core Event for .22 Training Rifles (100m, 75m, 50m) Graded /Junior.

Event 7: Match 20: 3P Core Event for .310 Cadet Rifles (100m, 75m, 50m) Graded / Junior.

Country Dinner served in dining room on Range 3 at 7:00 pm.

Sunday, 21st September, Rifle Events, Range 3: Rifle Scrutineering 8:30 am. Briefing at 9:15 am. Competition begins 9:30 am.

Event 8: Match 16: Long Range Event A, 300m - 12 Rounds per class. F1 Class on the Core Target, F2 on the Mini Core Target, T/J on the T4 Target. (Open)

Event 9: Match 17: Long Range Event B - 10 Rounds per class F1 Class on the Core Target, F2 on the Mini Core Target, T/J on the T4 Target. (Open)

Medals for all rifle events, Teams event, Top gun and Top gun Junior.

Top Gun and Teams event based on combined scores of standard rifle events 3,4 and 5.

Scoring and conduct of events:

It is planned to conduct a major component of this Championship utilizing electronic targetry. In the event that a shot has not been recorded by an electronic acoustic target, the competitor may be permitted to reshoot the unrecorded shot at the discretion of the Head Scorer. The competitor will be given realisable time for each unrecorded round of the relay.

Where electronic acoustic targets are being used for scoring, the intended electronic target system for centrefire rifles at the Championships will be the Shotmarker system. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their rifle and ammunition combination has the required velocity to register on the target. This can be checked on practice day and if the rounds do not register then a manual target will be available. Electronic acoustic targets must not be used for scoring Rimfire or Black Powder Cartridge Target Rifle events

It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that they attend the Championships with sufficient ammunition to deal with this eventuality. Events may be re-scheduled at the discretion of the Organisers to deal with changing circumstances such as inclement weather, etc.

Nomination Fees:

All Pistol Events \$50, All Rifle Events \$70, Individual events \$15. All Pistol and Rifle Events \$100.00. Juniors half price. Event nominations include sausage sizzle each day. Saturday Night Dinner \$40.00 per person.
